

## A former Technical Member or a coach who has had a break from coaching

### **STEP 1: Has your break from coaching / Technical Membership been less than 3 years?**

**YES ▶** You can either:

- Gain updating points to re-activate your Technical Membership – see the [Updating Policy](#) on the GA Website for further information and contact your State/Territory Association to add the updating to your records.
- Apply for Current Competency Coach Assessment (a practical assessment to show you are competent to coach). Apply to your State/Territory Association for an assessment.

**NO ▶** If you have had a break of 3 years or more from coaching / Technical Membership **then go to STEP 2.**

### **STEP 2: If you have had a break of more than 3 years form coaching / Technical Membership you have 2 options.**

You are required to complete a practical assessment to re-activate your Technical Membership. **You can either:**

- Register for the face to face course of a coaching accreditation. Go to [www.learning.gymnastics.org.au](http://www.learning.gymnastics.org.au) to register for a face to face course. If you are not able to enrol please contact your State/Territory Association for support.
- Apply to your State/Territory Association for an assessment in your gym to show you are competent. This is known as a [Current Competency Coach Assessment](#). You can find more about this form of assessment on the [GA Website](#).
